



## Child Safe Standard 7

### Four Elements of Child Safe Education

Element One: Standards of behaviour for students attending Osborne Primary School	
Is this in place?	Yes – there is a student code of conduct in place that is detailed under standard 3
Student voice	Within the first two weeks of each school year, students are heavily involved in designing, refining and articulating the expected and accepted behaviours for their classroom, year level and learning space.
Student Empowerment	All students are aware of the expected code of conduct and are able to articulate what is expected of themselves and others. The activities undertaken at the start of the school year and reviewed regularly provide multiple opportunities for students to be heard.
School promotion	The student code of conduct is available on the school website. The classroom or year level expectations are visible within the learning spaces.

Element Two: Healthy and respectful Relationships (including sexuality)	
Is this in place?	The Grade 5 and 6 students will be covering this through the curriculum in 2019 and beyond.
Materials used	Curriculum documents as mandated by the department of Education.
Professional Development	Teachers attend professional development sessions provided by the school and outside providers.

Element Three: Resilience	
Is this in place?	Yes the school is delivering education in this area in alignment with the learning standards under Personal and Social Capability and health and Physical education in the Victorian Curriculum.
Materials used	The school utilise 'Play is the Way' as the Social and Emotional learning Program. The school are continually working through the Kidsmatter modules and promoting Kidsmatter through the newsletter to the parent and broader community.
Professional Development	Teachers attend professional development sessions provided by the school and outside providers.

Element Four: Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention	
Is this in place?	Yes the school is delivering education in this area in alignment with the learning standards under Personal and Social Capability and Health and Physical education in the Victorian Curriculum.
Professional Development	In house professional development in line with Child Safe Standards. online completion of the Mandatory Reporting eLearning modules.
