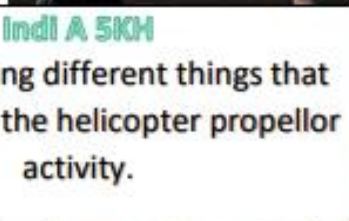
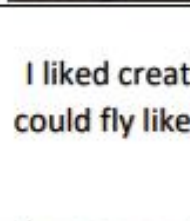
Gus 5LF
